



Bloodstock South Africa Online Conditions of Sales

In addition to the standard Bloodstock SA Conditions of Sale, the following special conditions will be applicable.

- The minimum price that will be accepted for any Horse at the Sale on the Online Auction is R10 000 excluding VAT.
- Purchasers are to ensure they have selected the correct lot/horse prior to placing their bids. No incorrect bids will be deleted.
- The highest bidder at the closing time of auction for each lot which is displayed individually on each lot's profile, will be deemed the Buyer of that lot.
- Payment for all lots purchased is due immediately after the sale has concluded into the Auctioneers designated Bank Account.
- Any horse on this sale excluding a broodmare, is subject to an upper respiratory endoscopic examination at the place of purchase, by the Purchaser within 72 hours from time of purchase ("the scope"), at the sole cost of the Purchaser. In the event that the attending veterinarian deems the scope to be unsatisfactory in terms of the BSA Conditions of Sale, the purchaser has the option to cancel the sale.
- Any vetting or inspection of a horse prior to the sale must be arranged directly with the Vendor, and not with Bloodstock SA.
- Any mare purchased that the Purchaser wishes to confirm being "Tested In Foal", may be tested at the place of purchase, by the Purchaser within 72 hours from time of purchase, at the sole cost of the Purchaser. In the event that the attending veterinarian deems the mare not to be in foal, the purchaser has the option to cancel the sale.
- A horse will only be released to the new purchaser once payment has been received by Bloodstock SA in full. BSA will then issue confirmation to both Seller & Purchaser to confirm release of the horse.
- Transport of horses purchased needs to be arranged by the Purchaser directly after the sale. All transport costs and boarding fees from Conclusion of Sale will be for the Purchasers account.
- All Purchasers are to arrange insurance directly with the Insurance Broker of choice if they wish to insure their purchase.
- Bloodstock SA or the Purchaser shall be entitled to cancel any sale, where information and/or images displayed on the online platform is found to be incorrect.
- BSA Added Stakes Program does not apply to horses purchased on the Online Auctions.

- The Vendor of any horse must disclose all known pre-existing conditions including injuries and/or deformities at the time of entering the horse onto the Online Auction.
- Please take note that Bloodstock South Africa does not accept responsibility for any delay in delivery of any electronic message and/or data relating to any auction, for any reason whatsoever. Please take further note that Bloodstock South Africa is not liable for any losses suffered by any person as a consequence of the above. Potential purchasers and vendors are advised to, at all times, remain on the auction site pending the finalisation of their purchases/sales.
